

Your responsibility as a Boarder at NanSea Stables:

Barn Care

Picking up all droppings your horse leaves in arena

- Cleaning the hair, dust, and trash from the aisle or grooming area when you care for your horse
- Cleaning the aisle or grooming area when your farrier visits
- Sweeping/Organization of your assigned tack area
- Turn Lights off and close Gates behind you
- All hoses to be rolled up after use

Safety Rules

- Riding is not permitted in Parking lot
- Riding is not permitted in the aisles of the barn
- Please walk in the lane to the trail head
- Please close each gate behind you on the trail
- Do not tie your horse in the round pen, or leave them unattended for more than 15 minutes.
- Riding helmets are suggested and proper footwear is required: Purchase and use of helmets is the responsibility of the rider, not Nan-Sea Stables Inc.
- No outside riders or horses without prior permission of the management. All riders must sign a "Waiver of Liability"
- Dogs must remain in your car or on a leash and must not bark at the horses
- Smoking is not permitted on the property
- When riding in opposite directions-pass left shoulder to left shoulder
- No jumping allowed outside a riding lesson without prior clearance from the management.
- Close the arena gates while riding
- If you turn your horse loose in the arena you must remain with him. No wall chewing or digging. If the footing is torn up-you must rake it smooth.
- You are obligated for your lesson when you schedule it. If you need to reschedule the lesson, it needs to be done at least one day in advance. When you cannot make a lesson and you call prior to one hour in advance you will be required to pay one half of the lesson fee. Failure to show for a lesson or call to cancel requires payment of the full lesson fee.
- Do not borrow equipment without prior permission

Daily Cleaning

- Automatic Waterer
- Stall and Run before dark each day (please notify management if you plan on being later)

Horse Care

- Grooming and exercising your horse
- Routine and Emergency Vet Care
- Worming
- Scheduling and making payments to the Farrier
- Mortality and Liability Insurance coverage for personal injury to others by your horse
- Equine Dental Care
- Stall Confinement is not permitted without Vet Prescription
- Any additional grains not provided by NanSea stables must be bagged and placed in the 2nd feed room
- Written notice of any feed changes must be given to management
